 - **4:30 pm to 5:00 pm** : Offering Dana to All new Monks and Sayadaws (about 20 monks) by Family members + Other Laymen & laywomen. (Expect 50+plus layperson may participate to offer dana) = [Total participants may be 70 to 80]
 - **5:00 pm to 5:30 pm** : The Sermon, Water Libation and Share Merit.
 - **5:30 pm** : Sayadawgyi and group will leave for the new rented place.
